This proposal must include the following elements: Goals and objectives as they relate to the goals and curriculum of the School District, number of students impacted by this proposal, how are the results measurable, how does the proposal have the potential to involve the community in some way if any, and does the proposal have the potential to become part of the regular school district curriculum or extracurricular offerings. Please also include the amount you are requesting for your proposal and the total expected cost of your proposal. If the total is more than your grant request please detail how you expect to obtain the additional funds for your proposal.
